## Laid-off workers can find health insurance on site

Laid-off workers can turn to a Web site to help them obtain health insurance, according to the state Department of Insurance.

The site – [www.coverageforall.org](http://www.coverageforall.org) – is operated by the San Jose nonprofit Foundation for Health Coverage Education.

The foundation also operates a "U.S. Uninsured Help Line" that can be reached by calling (800) 234-1317.

Foundation for Health Coverage Education provides access to hundreds of state and federal programs nationwide and can link parties to nearly 200 public health care program applications online.

"A lot of people don't know these programs exist," said Phil Lebherz, founder of Foundation for Health Coverage Education.
